

Washgate – Notification under Regulation 12 of the National Park Authorities’ Traffic Orders (Procedure) (England) Regulations 2007

Following the meeting of the Audit Resources and Performance Committee in September 2016, the Authority is seeking views on a modification to the proposed traffic regulation order (TRO) at Washgate to exclude mechanically propelled vehicles save for named motorcycle trials.

The notice of proposed modification and the statement of reasons for the proposed modification are attached to this letter for information. As background, the proposed order, a statement giving the reasons for the order and a map showing the extent of the proposed restriction can be viewed at www.peakdistrict.gov.uk/consultations and at Aldern House from 8.45am to 5pm Monday to Friday (closed Bank and Public Holidays).

Before any decision is taken on how to proceed with the making of a traffic regulation order, the consultation responses will be considered by the Authority’s Audit Resource and Performance Committee. When published, the report for consideration by the Committee will be available at www.peakdistrict.gov.uk/committees.
